What will we be learning this term?

Language - Reading, Writing, Listening and Talking

This term the pupils will continue to work on their tricky words and new phonetic sounds.

In reading we will be working on our comprehension skills and writing about our favourite character and part of our reading book.

We will be focusing on functional writing and writing instructions and a recipe. We will learn how to use openers to start a sentence and include verbs in our writing.



Mathematics

The class will continue to learn number bonds in class, we will be setting exciting challenges for them to complete. We will focus on numbers to 100. These are heavily linked to our SEAL programme, which we continue to work through at an appropriate pace for each child.

The children will be learning about time using clocks. They will learn o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past



Health & Well-being

We will be focusing on Building Resilience and how we can be positive and kind even when we find things challenging.

In PE our focus will be on strength speed and agility with games and challenges in the gym hall.

The P2s will be taking part in our exciting, 'Roots of Empathy,' project where they meet a baby and learn about child development.

The P3s will continue to learn Growth Mindset and learn about a positive mindset and to share their feelings.



Expressive Arts

This term we will be learning songs for our nativity. The class are very excited and will be learning lots of new songs.

We will also be learning how to perform in front of an audience this year and I am sure that you will look forward to seeing your child perform!



Art this term will be linked to the Christian festival of Christmas. We will be designing our own Christmas cards and decorations using different types of media.



IDL Learning

This term we start our new topic of houses and homes around the world. The pupils discussed what they knew and wanted to learn.

We will be building our own homes using technology and art, looking at homes around the world and the materials that are used to build them. We also look at different types of homes around our local area and the materials used to build them.
