## What will we be learning this term?

### *Language - Reading, Writing, Listening and Talking*

In Literacy this term we will: -

Develop our ability in imaginative and functional writing.

Develop and vary our use of VCOP & sentence structure to make our writing even more interesting.

Encouraging independent and group reading through personal choice and school reading schemes.

Enhance our listening & talking skills through group discussion & presentation.

### *Social Studies*

Compare and contrast what life was like for ordinary people during the war and now.

Research and complete a homework project.

Understand the importance of why propaganda was used in relation to WW2.



### *Technologies*

In Technologies this term we will

Learning how to code using the Sphero balls

Design and construct an Anderson shelter and a gas mask.

Create a radio podcast to announce the start/end of World War 2.



## *Expressive Arts*

In expressive Arts we will: -

Music- In Music, Primary 7 will continue to create arrangements of well-known pieces of music and will be working in groups to showcase their performances. The children will also be working towards a performance at the Christmas Assembly.

Study the work of artist Henry Moore who was commissioned by the War Artists Advisory Committee to make drawings of people in London using underground stations as bomb shelters.

In Health and Well-being, we will: -

Whole school focus on 'Being Kind to Others' within the Building Resilience programme.
