

Primary 6 Intended Learning Plan



What will we be learning this term?

Language - Reading, Writing, Listening and Talking

In Literacy this term we will be continuing to develop our listening and talking skills.

In reading, pupils will continue to focus on developing fluency, expression and comprehension whilst developing Blooms Taxonomy skills.

Spelling work will continue each week, with a homework activity to complete on each spelling pattern.

In writing, pupils will be learning about sentence structure and up levelling their work. We will also focus on paragraphs and using a wider variety of punctuation.



Mathematics

This term we will be focusing on fractions, decimals and percentages and our mental arithmetic skills. During these lessons we will be discussing how we can implement different strategies to answer questions and show each other how we have achieved this.

We will also focus on solving real life maths problems, developing our ability to decode problems expressed in word form and looking closely at problem solving strategies and methods.

In topic maths we will learn about 3D Shape and Data and Analysis.



Social Studies

In Social Studies, we will investigate a Scottish historical theme to discover how past events or the actions of individuals or groups have shaped Scottish society. This will involve placing an event appropriately within a historical timeline and describing and discussing at least three similarities and differences between their own life and life in a past society.



STEM

P6 will be continuing to revise and improve our skills on TEAMS.

This term we will be learning how batteries work, building electric circuits for different purposes using a variety of different components including making an organic battery using potatoes!

We will also be investigating all our senses; sight, hearing, taste, smell and touch and considering sensory impairment such as sight and hearing loss and ways these impairments can be compensated for by the other senses and specialised adaptations and equipment.



Expressive Arts

In art we will be participating in a variety of activities linked to Chinese New Year and our Social Studies topic.

Primary 6 will continue to have their music lessons on a Tuesday with Mrs Ewen. This term, we will be working towards a performance of 'The Curse of MacCabra Opera House' in partnership with Scottish Opera. This will involve developing our drama skills too.

In drama, we will also take part in role play linked to our Social Studies topic.



Health & Well-Being

We will be continuing with the Building Resilience programme. This term's focus is 'Have a Goal'.

Additionally, P6 will continue to work on developing a growth mindset.

Our Equalities reps continue to do a great job and we will be learning about LGBTQ+ this term. Our equalities reps will help deliver a lesson to their class on this subject.

Primary 6 will also continue to have PE with Mr Devine on a Wednesday and Thursday. The focus this term will be cricket and basketball.
