What will we be learning this term?

Language - Reading, Writing, Listening and Talking

This term we will continue to explore language and spelling patterns. Please support your child by helping them memorise their “tricky words” and any words or phonic sounds highlighted in their reading record. We will be learning about compound words, and we are sure the children will enjoy exploring this. We will continue to work on joining words in our sentences.

We will be learning about different punctuation, proper nouns and adverbs as part of grammar.



Mathematics

As well as continuing to develop our numeracy skills through the SEAL programme, focussing on addition, subtraction and timetables we will be learning all about money.

We will be adding coins and taking away coins to give change. In the classroom we will be setting up a shop so that pupils realise the value of money.

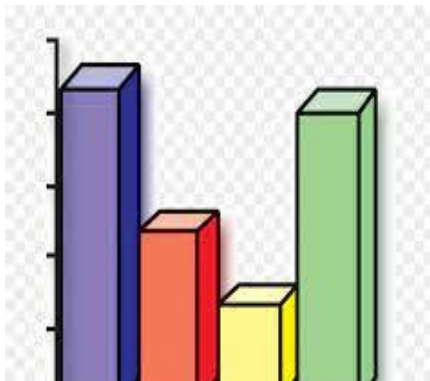
Primary 2/3 will also be creating their own graphs, tally charts and pictograms when we are exploring data analysis.



Technologies/ICT

We will use the smartboard and I pads to support learning in the classroom such learning adding coins to different values, making bar charts and collecting data.

For STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) this term will work in teams to build bridges with loose parts play outside.



Science

This term we will be learning about the human body. We will cover different parts of the body and their functions.

We will participate in experiments, labelling parts of the body and asking questions about how our body works.



Expressive Arts

Primary 2/3 will be using their voice, musical instruments and music technology to accompany well known traditional stories. This will be an opportunity for the pupils to explore how to use sound, rhythm, tempo, pitch and dynamics in their music.

This term we have a dance teacher pupils will be learning different types of dance and taking part in games.



Health & Well-Being/RME

In Health and Wellbeing this term, the focus will be 'Expect the Unexpected'. We will be learning about change and how to deal with it in a positive way. We will be discussing the transition from current classes to new classes next session.

Our focus in gym will be athletics this term. They will be learning how run relay races, take part in the long and high jump in preparation for our Sport's Day.
