



Primary 5/4 Intended Learning Plan



What will we be learning this term?

Language - Reading, Writing, Listening and Talking



Through a variety of reading opportunities, pupils will select texts and explain their preferences. Pupils will also work in their reading groups to create different kinds of questions to show their understanding.

In writing we will develop our skills when sharing information, including giving instructions, explanations and describing events.

Spelling work will continue with a focus on adding suffixes.

It is hoped that involvement in our school show will provide good talking and listening opportunities and developing confidence when speaking to an audience.

Numeracy and Maths

We have started with a focus on fractions. Pupils have been able to describe, order and compare simple fractions, using the correct notation, as well as calculating the fraction of a quantity.



This term we will investigate money, using coins and notes to pay for items and give change. We will also consider how goods can be paid for and look at affordability and budgets through our enterprise topic.

We will look at expressions and equations, creating and answering missing number problems and revisiting our understanding of mathematical language and symbols.

Finally, we will collate and display data in a variety of ways.

Health and Wellbeing

Our focus this term is recognising our strengths and interests and finding out about the wider world of work.

We will also be learning about food, including finding out about seasonality, food journeys and exploring our food practices and preferences.



Our Building Resilience topic this term is *Expect the Unexpected*. This has been introduced to the children through an assembly and will be followed up with classroom-based activities.



In PE this term, Mr Devine will be developing skills in throwing and catching and athletics.

IDL



Primary 5/4 are super excited this term as they will be performing 'Bamboozled- An Extraordinary Musical Adventure.'

During this project the children will experience different roles involved in the production of a show, decision making and simple budgets.

Lights, camera, action! This term we are very lucky to be working with a production team from Media Education. Pupils are learning how to become film makers and create a documentary about our school and play.



Expressive Arts



In Music and drama, Primary 5/4 will be working towards a performance of the musical called 'Bamboozled'. This will be a great opportunity for the pupils to continue developing their singing and performance skills, including working from a script.

In addition to this, we are also having ukulele lessons. Pupils have already made great progress and are producing some great sounds!

This term P5/4 will have a block of dance lessons from Ms Bonewell, our dance teacher.



In art we will create possible designs for costumes linked to our show.

Science/French



This term we will be visited by Generation Science. This practical workshop will allow children to explore simple chemical reactions whilst having a lot of fun!

We will also investigate sound and light, looking at shadows, reflections and finding out how animals communicate.

This term we will continue to improve our French speaking skills. We will cover topics including greetings, our family, weather and food.
