

# Primary 6 Intended Learning Plan T4

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# What will we be learning this term?

# Language - Reading, Writing, Listening and Talking

In Literacy this term we will be continuing to develop our listening and talking skills.

In reading, pupils will continue to focus on developing fluency, expression and comprehension whilst developing Blooms
Taxonomy questioning skills.

Spelling work will continue each week, with a homework activity to complete on each spelling pattern.

In writing, pupils will be learning about using more ambitious punctuation and connectives. We will also focus on creating a leaflet and writing instructions.



### **Mathematics**

This term we will be focusing on Multiplication and Division and Algebra, focusing on developing speed and accuracy with mental calculations and having sound knowledge of times tables. In Algebra, we will be learning about basic equations and how to solve them.

We will continue to develop problem solving strategies and methods.

In topic maths we will learn about Measure, Co-ordinates and revise Time.



# Health & Well-Being

We will be continuing with the Building Resilience programme. This terms focus is 'Expect the Unexpected'.

We will be learning about the physical and emotional changes which occur during puberty, helping us understand why they are taking place and the importance of personal hygiene. We will also learn about Reproduction, how human life begins and how a baby is born. Finally, we will focus on the topic of Keeping Myself Safe.

Primary 6 will also continue to have **PE** with Mr Devine on a Wednesday and Thursday. The focus this term will be athletics.



#### **STEM**

P6 will be continuing to develop our skills on TEAMS.

This term in Science we will be investigating the **Solar System**. Firstly we will explore how the Earth spins around its axis in 24 hours resulting in day and night and how the Earth takes one year to completely orbit the sun.

We will also observe and record the different patterns of movement of the moon and explain why the moon appears to have different shapes and positions in the sky at different times in a lunar month.

Lastly, we will explore how the tilt of the Earth causes the pattern of the seasons and changes to the number of daylight hours over the course of a year.



## **Expressive Arts**

In art we will learn about different artists and their styles. We will create our own interpretive drawings and paintings.

Primary 6 will continue to have their music lessons on a Tuesday with Mrs Ewen. This term, we will be exploring ways of creating different atmospheric pieces of music using Garageband.

In drama, we will focus on emotions and how we express them.
