

Primary 4 Intended Learning Plan





Language - Reading, Writing, Listening and Talking

In spelling this term we will continue to look at common prefixes and suffixes. In writing, we will focus on explanation, instruction and persuasive texts and pupils will spend time self-editing their work.

In listening and talking, pupils will be learning to make simple notes to summarise what they have watched or listened to.

In reading, pupils will continue to focus on developing fluency, expression and comprehension. We will also be concentrating on developing children's understanding of using contents, index and glossary pages

Maths and Numeracy

In Maths & Numeracy this term, we will investigate fractions. We will compare and order simple fractions and learn about equivalent fractions.

We will also revisit patterns and relationships. Pupils will create their own simple number patterns and describe the rule they have used to make it.

Another maths focus will be to apply our knowledge of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division to solve real-life problems.

Finally, we will be investigating data handling. Pupils will learn how to read a variety of graphs and tables, as well as creating their own.

Health and Wellbeing

In Health and Wellbeing, we will be continuing to work on our building resilience programme. This term will be 'Respect Yourself'. This has been introduced to the children through an assembly and will be followed up with classroom-based activities.

In class, we will be looking at the RSHP programme at first level and covering some of the topics including: - Everyone is unique, but we have similarities and differences and disability. Information on this programme can be found at www.rshp.scot/first/

In Gym, pupils will work with our PE specialist, Mr Devine. Their focus will be **Athletics**.



Science

This term we will be developing our scientific enquiry and investigation skills and knowledge and understanding as we explore the following topics-

- Energy
- Forces
- Magnets
- Electrical circuits
- Sound





Expressive Arts

In music, using the book 'Wild Symphony' by Dan Brown, Primary 4 will be learning about instrument families in an orchestra and creating their own music to represent different animals.

In drama this term we will focus on creating and presenting ideas, and plan to share a short performance during our class assembly.

In art, we will take inspiration from our wild challenge to create drawings of the plants and animals found in our local green spaces.



IDL- Wild Challenge



This term we will be exploring nature and helping wildlife as P4 have signed up for the RSPB Wild Challenge. It is hoped that we will be successful in achieving the Bronze Award by completing three 'Help Nature' and three 'Experience Nature' activities.

So far, the pupils have carried out and completed a plant safari at a local park and have used their experience at Forest Schools to inspire some wild writing. We and looking forward to participating in a further 4 fun activities and hopefully achieving the award.
