

# Primary 5 Intended Learning Plan - Term 4



## What will we be learning this term?

### *Language - Reading, Writing, Listening and Talking*

In Literacy this term we will be applying all the skills we have learnt over the year to create our own imaginative stories, focusing on including character and scene description as well as how to write in paragraphs.

P5 will continue to focus on weekly spelling patterns using different strategies to support spelling words correctly.

In reading, we will continue to develop our comprehension skills using literacy boxes and reading in our groups.

In French, we will be working on delivering a brief presentation on a familiar topic.

P5 will be continuing Mandarin with Mrs. Ding on a Wednesday afternoon.



### *Mathematics*

In Maths & Numeracy this term we will focus on Measure – length, area and perimeter.

We will also be learning about Time, working on reading and recording time in both 12-hour and 24-hour notation and converting between the two.

Another maths focus will be Algebra, patterns and relationships.

We will continue to work on times tables, word problems and the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division).



### *Health & Well-being*

In Health and Well-being, we will continue our work on Building Resilience. Our theme for this term will be 'Respect Yourself'.

This term our Equalities reps will deliver another lesson to P5. We will continue to learn about how to keep ourselves safe.

We will also be learning about important skills and make connections between skills and the world of work.

In P.E, Primary 5 pupils will work with our PE specialist, Mr Devine and will be focusing on Athletics this term.



### *Sciences*

In Science, Primary 5 will be learning about sound, light and shadows. We will explore how animals communicate, the formation of shadows and the mixing of coloured lights.

We will also be exploring water, learning about the water cycle, dissolving and separating and water purification.



## Social Studies

In Social Studies we will learn about goods and services, business and enterprise in Scotland and in other countries.

The pupils will experience setting up and running a small enterprise and explore ethical trading.



## Expressive Arts

Following last term's wonderful progress in Music, Primary 5 will continue to read, play and compose different melodies to be performed on the recorder this term.

In Drama, we will focus on experimenting with movement, expression and voice to communicate ideas, thoughts and feelings.

In Art, we will create images and objects which show our awareness and recognition of detail. We will also create artwork linked to our learning in RME.
